5.	Based on Ecclesiastes 4:4-6, what are the wrong responses and a correct response to God's rule over time?
6.	What does Hebrews 4 say about the rest God has made for His people to enjoy?
7.	What wisdom does Psalm 90 offer about how to live in light of the brevity of life?
