The path of justification by our works leads to God's curse, but the path of Justification by faith in Christ leads to God's blessing.

Definitions

Justification is an instantaneous legal act of God in which He (1) thinks of our sins as forgiven and Jesus' righteousness as belonging to us, and so (2) declares us to be righteous/not guilty before Him. (Wayne Grudem)

Legalism is any attempt to gain acceptance or forgiveness from God through own efforts or merits.
