In Matthew 6:5-15, Jesus provides a model for believers to develop a godly prayer life.

1. Motive in daily prayer (6:5-8)

- *Where you pray (5-6)*
- *How you pray (7-8)*

2. Priorities in daily prayer (6:9-13)

- *For Him (9-10)*
- *For us and Him (11-13)*

3. Fellowship in daily prayer (6:14-15)

- ***God's part - initiating***

- ***Our part - imitating***

Questions to Consider

1. What was the primary motive of the hypocrites in prayer (6:5-8)? What should our motive be?
2. How does Jesus' model for prayer contrast with the prayers of the hypocrites (6:7-13)?
3. From the order and focus of the prayers in Jesus' model, what should our prayers focus on first?
4. What does the statement in Matthew 6:13, "And do not lead us into temptation, but deliver us from evil," mean? How does James 1:13-15 help guide our understanding?
5. What did Jesus mean when He said, "But if you do not forgive others, then your Father will not forgive your transgressions" (6:15)? How do Ephesians 4:32 and 1st John 1:9 help us understand Jesus' warning?
